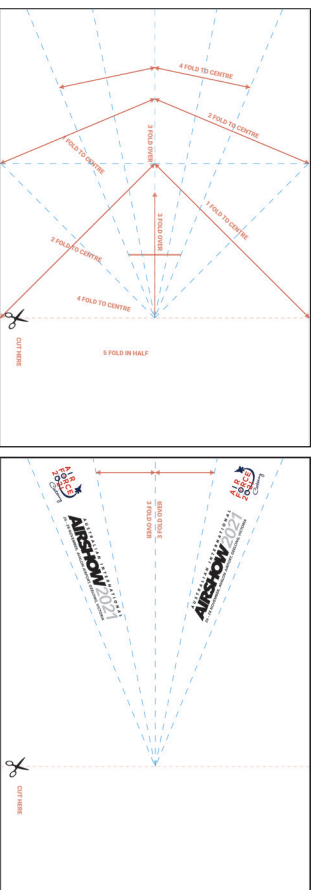

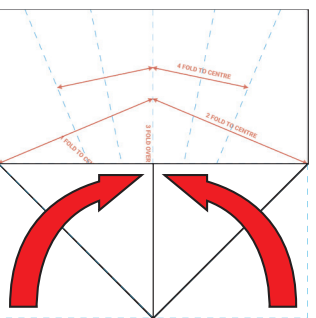

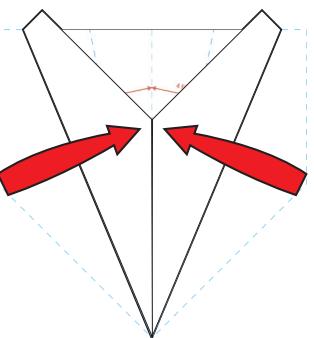
Print off your paper plane double sided. Cut the page along the line as shown.

Tip: Your printer settings should be set to "Flip on long edge" when printing!



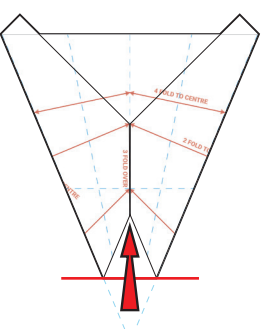
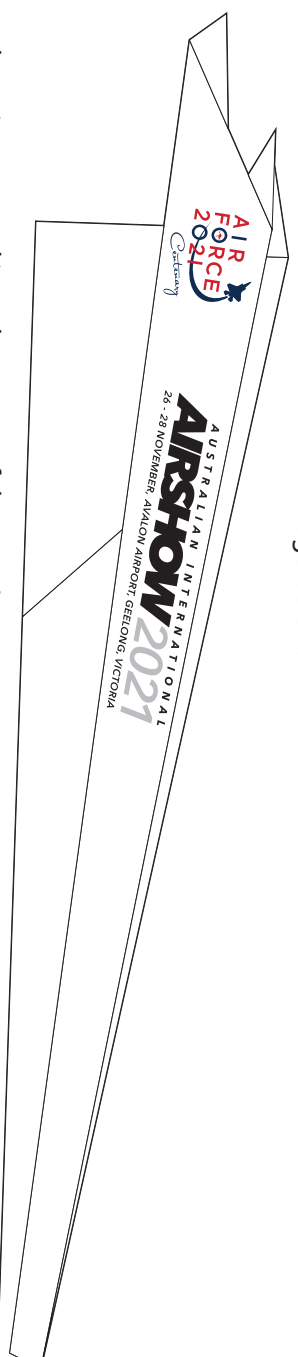
Step 2: Fold the top and bottom right corners into the centre of the page.

Tip: You should now have two equal triangles on the top and bottom!



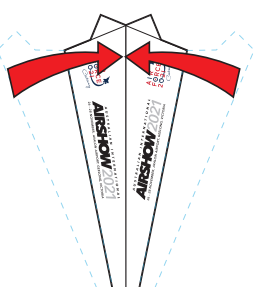
Step 3: Fold the new top and bottom right corners you have just created into the centre of the page!

Tip: Your plane's wings should now stick out over the edge of the paper!



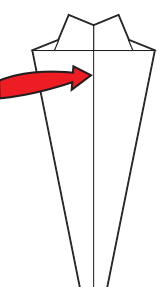
Step 4: Fold the page inward along the red line

Tip: Your plane should have a flat nose now. You can experiment by folding inwards further away, or closer to the point of the nose!



Step 5: Fold the corners of your wings into the center again.

Tip: You should now be able to see the AIRSHOW 2021 Logo!



Step 6: Flip your plane upside down, and then fold it in half.

Tip: Your paper plane is ready to fly! It should look a bit like the image below.
